Following the validation of the French Paralympic and Sports Committee (CPSF), Serge Lecomte, President of the French Equestrian Federation and Sophie Dubourg, National Technical Director, announce the list of riders and horses selected to represent France during the Paris 2024 Paralympic Games from August 28 to 8 September.

### **Fanny Delaval, Discipline Director**

"We chose to select four combinations who have been very convincing since the beginning of the 2024 season, which was important for selections. This team has a lot of qualities and excellent cohesion. The riders all know each other and work very well together.

Our choice was made with a view of the individual title in mind. We know that we only have a very slim chance for a team podium, but, on the other hand, we have combinations who can challenge the best individually, mainly in Grade III and IV. We have two experienced combinations with Chiara/Swing and Vladimir/Pégase who have already participated in the Paralympic Games in Tokyo in 2021, and two younger combinations Alexia/Sultan and Lisa/Stallone who are on the rise and have worked a lot and are very consistent. Beyond technique, work on mental preparation is essential to succeed when performing in Paris. This selection choice is a collective decision of the entire sports management team. We presented it to the selection council on July 1 who was on the same wavelength. »
